The Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles further informs all Filipinos and Filipino-Americans in **Southern California, Southern Nevada and State of Arizona** of the following CoViD-19 Developments:

### **California**

The State continues to see a downward trend in CoViD-19 cases and hospitalizations, resulting in more Counties being moved to a less restrictive reopening tier category.

**All Counties in Southern California are now under the “moderate community transmission” or ORANGE TIER reopening category.** Health protocols on the permitted **indoor businesses and activities, with certain modifications**, under this category could be accessed [here](#).

### **Nevada**

The Nevada CoViD-19 Response Team recently approved **Clark County's Local Mitigation and Enforcement Plan, easing capacity and social distance restrictions beginning 01 May 2021.** Buffets, nightclubs, and adult entertainment venues can also reopen. Details on the plan are available [here](#).

### **Arizona**

Arizona Governor Douglas Anthony Ducey issued **Executive Order 2021-06** dated 25 March 2021 dubbed, “New Phase of CoViD-19 Mitigation Business Guidelines Transition from Requirements to Recommendations,” **lifting all CoViD-19 related business and activity restrictions.** The Order can be viewed [here](#).
