**PUBLIC ADVISORY FOR  
TRAVELERS TO THE PHILIPPINES  
TRANSITING AT THE AIRPORTS IN THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA**

**12 January 2022, Los Angeles** – The Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles informs the public that all travelers to the Philippines transiting at airports in the Republic of Korea (ROK) that they are **required** to present proof of a **negative CoViD-19 Reverse Transcription-Polymerase Chain Reaction (RT-PCR) test result taken within 72 hours** prior to departure.

The public is further informed that there are **NO CoViD-19 testing facilities inside Korean airports for transiting passengers**. The testing facilities located after immigration services are only for passengers entering Korea.

Those who cannot present a negative RT-PCR at Korean airports during their transit will be asked to leave the terminal to take the test.

Further, all passengers are required to wear a mask inside the airport regardless of vaccination status.
