OVER 550 CONSULAR CLIENTS SERVED AS PHILCONGEN LA CONDUCTS OUTREACH IN SAN DIEGO, CA



**PHILCONGEN LA RENDERS MORE THAN
550 CONSULAR SERVICES IN SAN DIEGO**



29 August 2024, Los Angeles – The Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles conducted a consular outreach mission to San Diego, CA from 17 to 18 August 2024. This outreach mission, held at the Otay Ranch Mall in Chula Vista, was conducted in collaboration with the Philippine Honorary Consulate in San Diego led by HonCon Audie De Castro, Council of Philippine American Organizations (COPA) led by their President, Mr. Joe Mazares.

The team rendered a total of 414 consular services, including ePassport issuance (117 clients), dual citizenship petitions (100 clients), civil registry (4 clients), and consular notarization (45 documents). Additionally, 148 new overseas voters were registered and will now be able to exercise their right to suffrage in the upcoming 2025 Mid-term Elections.

The outreach team was led by Consul Francis Maynard S. Maleon (signing officer), the team included Ligaya Sarabia (cashier); Annabelle Sagum and Aristotle De Leon (passport encoders); Edelwina Valencia (dual citizenship processor); Maria Teresa Villanueva (notarization and civil registry processor); and Elvis Tamayo (OV Registration).

Additionally, Vice Consul Levi Anthony B. Malaylay led joint Assistance to Nationals (ATN) activities composed of Labor Attaché Macy Monique A. Maglanque, Assistant Labor Attaché Maria Corazon Venus N. Abad, PCol Maria Cecile M. Vilorio and PEMS Reynaldo C. Estino of the Office of the Police Attaché - Liaison Office in the US West Coast (OPA-LOWC) and ATN Officer Ma. Antoinette B. Villa. The ATN Team provided services to an additional 140 clients.
