OVER 500 SERVICES PROVIDED AT THE 2-DAY CONSULAR AND OVERSEAS VOTING OUTREACH IN PHOENIX, ARIZONA



28 April 2025, Los Angeles – A team from the Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles conducted a consular and overseas voting outreach in Phoenix, Arizona from 26 to 27 April 2025. This outreach mission, held at the St. Joseph Catholic Church, was organized in collaboration with the Filipino American Business Chamber of Commerce of Arizona (FABCCA).

Led by Consul Francis Maynard S. Maleon, the team rendered a total of 510 consular services, including ePassport issuance (174 clients), dual citizenship petitions (117 clients), civil registry (20 clients), consular notarization (134 documents) and Overseas Voter Pre-enrollment/Voting (65 clients).

Also present during the outreach were representatives from the Philippine Department of Tourism – Los Angeles, who promoted the Very Important Pinoy (VIP) Tour, and from the Office of the Police Attaché-Liaison Office in the US West Coast (OPA-LOWC), who set up a help desk to answer queries on police clearances and other concerns.
