LOS ANGELES – The Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles, in partnership with the Council of Philippine American Organizations (COPAO), led by Mr. Joseph “Joe” Mazares, conducted a consular outreach mission in San Diego, California from 21 to 22 June 2025. Over the two-day mission, the team rendered a total of 246 consular services, which included passport, dual citizenship, notarial and civil registry services, to overseas Filipinos living in San Diego and nearby cities, as well as those from other states.
