10 November 2025 – The Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles hosted a Roundtable Discussion on Tax Policy Reforms in the Philippines on 06 November 2025, co-hosted by Mr. Raymond “Mon” Abrea, Founding Chairman and Chief Tax Advisor of the Asian Consulting Group (ACG). The event was attended by select leaders from the Filipino-American business community and Chambers of Commerce.

In his welcome remarks, Consul General Adelio Angelito S. Cruz expressed his appreciation to Mr. Abrea as the topic of tax policy reforms was a timely reassurance for the Filipino-American community to continue investing and doing business in the Philippines.

Mr. Abrea’s presentation focused on the Philippine CREATE MORE Tax (Corporate Recovery and Tax Incentives for Enterprises to Maximize Opportunities for Reinvigorating the Economy) whose implementation and compliance would contribute to the transformation of the economy. He also shared ACG’s tax policy proposals whose goals were to strengthen the Philippines’ tax framework.

The participants’ interest was evident as they sought Mr. Abrea’s insights on how the Filipino-American community could help the Philippine economy. Mr. Abrea conveyed that international forums such as this provided an opportunities to exchange insights and feedback. Mr. Abrea also encouraged the participants to take advantage of sustainable investment opportunities in the Philippines. END.
